

The Karnataka Urban Water Supply and Drainage Board was constituted by an Act of legislature in 1974 and is functioning from August 1975.


The Board is an implementing body for Water Supply and UGD facilities in 213 Urban local bodies of the State except Bruhat Bangalore Mahanagara Palike.

The Board aims to provide adequate water supply from assured and safe source of supply and also proper sanitation to all the urban areas. There are 213 urban local bodies coming under the jurisdiction of the Board, under the following categories:

1 **UIDSSMT** programme

The Board is executing 17 water supply and 9 Under Ground Drainage schemes at an estimate cost of Rs.418.07 crores and 64.91 crores respectively under the Centrally sponsored **UIDSSMT** programme. 7 water supply schemes are commissioned. The remaining 10 water supply schemes and 9 under ground drainage schemes are targeted for commissioning during 2013-14

2. JnnURM programme

The Board has takenup remodeling of existing distribution network, Automation and Integrated Management System of Mysore city under the Jawaharalal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission centrally sponsored scheme at an estimating cost of Rs.194.54 Crores, and Augmentation of water supply scheme from Kabini river has been taken up at an estimated cost of Rs.108.81 crores under **JnnURM**

Action Plan for the year 2012-13

The action plan consisting of 151 schemes which includes schemes commissioned during previous years and to be completed during 2012-13, schemes targeted for commissioning during 2012-13, ongoing schemes and New Schemes proposed during the year 2012-13. The Board budget for the year 2012-13 is amounting to Rs. 892.96 crores. The Action Plan was sanctioned by GOK vide G.O. No. UDD/71/UWS/2012 dt: 12.02.2013. The Plan allocation in the State Budget for the year 2012-13 was Rs.368.00 Crores.

Water & Waste water learning center, Yelahanka., Bangalore

Karnataka Urban Water Supply & Drainage Board have purchased 66,476 Sqft (1 Acres 21 Guntas) Land for the construction and development of training center at Yelahanka, Bangalore exclusively for water supply and sanitation sector. On the above land, a training center of 22232 Sqft built up area is constructed. This building comprises of basement with a dining hall, Water test laboratory and recreation facilities. The ground floor consists of reception, lounge, water supply structure exhibition areas, training halls, administration sections and computer laboratory. The first floor consists of one exhibition hall for UGD system and discussion room and water supply equipment - exhibition. The second floor is provided with a hostel facilities with well furnished 6 double rooms, 14 beds gents dormitory and 10 bed women dormitory & a common hall with DTH TV. The computer laboratory is provided with internet facilities also a library is provided.

The water & Waste water learning center has started conducting training programs for officers & officials of the board in the cadre of Executive Engineers to Data Entry Operator from May 2011. During 2012-13, 15 training programs have been conducted on various subjects. This also includes 1 No of foundation training for the newly appointed Assistant Engineers. The training center has trained about 436 Engineers.

The resource persons are drawn from Engineering colleges, KUWS & D Board, BWSSB, NVTQC, ISCE etc., Apart from this well informed retired officers of the rank of Engineers in Chief, Chief Engineer as well as few consulting firms.

The method of training adopted includes lectures, interactive classroom session, exercise on case studies as well as group discussion & assignments. The training sessions are also aided by a state of the art, audio – visual presentation system & computer labs.

The training center intends to give training to the administrators, engineers, skilled labour and also elected representatives on the subject of water supply and sanitation from urban local bodies. The exhibitions will also cater to the above as well as general public. The training center will also take new technology and visionary projects under water supply and sanitation sector.

Reforms undertaken in Board to increase efficiency

- Development and Implementation of Management Information System (MIS) through Wide Area Network and Local Area Network by computerizing all the Offices in the State in collaboration with M/s Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore and M/s Tata Consultants, Bangalore.
- Award of ISO 9001 2008 Certification for all the Offices of the Board across the State, the first Board to obtain such Certification in India.
- To have best quality in execution of works, third party inspections of schemes have been introduced.
- For speedy and timely completion of the projects, contracts have been awarded through package tender to the pre-qualified firms.
- To have transparency and speedy finalization of tenders, E-Tendering has been implemented in the Board.
- Planning, Design and Monitoring Cell in the Central Office has been created for speedy implementation of the projects.
- To have efficient disposal of LOCs, a customized software has been developed and implemented for release of funds directly to the firms/contractors which again is not existing in any of the Government Departments or Boards/ Corporations of Karnataka.
- Development and installation of customised software for revenue billing & collection for Hubli-Dharwad Maintenance division.
- The Board established "Water and Waste Water Learning Centre" at Yelahanka, Bangalore to train the Board employees, local body authorities and public.
